# CHRISTIANS AND IMMODEST DRESS Mark Lindley

"In the Good Ole Summertime" is the name of a song that was popular in the 1940's. As the song suggests, summer is a great time of year, a time for baseball, grilling, fishing, and family vacation. But there is one thing about summer that is not good immodesty. When the mercury begins to rise in the hot summer sun, many begin wearing apparel in public that is too tight, too thin, too low, too short, and too revealing in general. Short-shorts, tight tops which draw attention to the female form and expose the midriff, ultra low-rider jeans and the like are all very "stylish," but these are not appropriate for Christians to wear.

The media and advertising industry in our country strongly influence and shape cultural standards of modesty. Women dressed in very brief attire are often seen on television, billboards, and in magazines. Because immodesty is so common and blatant, we have gradually lost our ability to feel any shame about it.

Christians, however, are to keep themselves "unspotted from the world" (James 1:27). Rather than accepting what the culture defines as modest, Christians must recognize the Bible as the supreme standard to follow (II Timothy 3:16-17). So, note what the Bible says about immodesty: "In like manner also, that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with shamefacedness and sobriety..." (I Timothy 2:9). This verse teaches that there is such a thing as "modest apparel," and that women are to wear such apparel. Failing to do so will lead others into the sin of lust. Jesus said, "But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart" (Matthew 5:28). There is no normal man who can look at a scantily clad woman for very long without having impure thoughts. Is the man wrong for such thoughts? Yes, but the woman who led the man into sin is guilty as well. Jesus pronounced a "woe" upon the one who causes another to stumble (Luke 17:1-2).

So, friends, let's enjoy the "good ole summertime"; but while we are outside having fun in the sun, let's remember that the Bible, not the culture, is the standard that should govern the way we dress.
