267th POPE ELECTED

The Catholic Church has just elected the 267th Pope, Robert Francis Prevost, age 69. He immediately took the name of Leo XIV. He is the first American to hold the office. The News Media, Catholics, and others, are all excited about this, with thousands in attendance, and hours given to coverage. Sharon Pannell does not share this excitement. See her thoughts on Facebook or ask her. This writer does not share the optimism of many for many reasons.

First, the writer asked his wife, "What part of what you have just seen reminds you of anything you have read in the scripture about Jesus?" She responded, "Nothing."

Second, it is said of the Pope, "The Pope cannot make a mistake when acting as head of the church and when teaching religion to the whole world." (the PARISH CATECHISM, by Father Farrell, updated and revised, Page 51, Number 9). This book carries the "Nihil Obstat" and "Imprimatur" of two of Catholic's "Reverend" and "Most Reverend" teachers, yet it is said, "The Nihil Obstat and Imprimatur are official declarations that a book or pamphlet is free of doctrinal or moral error. No implication is contained therein that those who have granted the Nihil Obstat and Imprimatur agree with the contents, opinions, or statements expressed." (Page 1). Third, public records say Pope Francis, former Pope, told a young boy whose father was an atheist, and asked if his father would go to heaven, "He was a good man; the Lord will not abandon him.
