RESERVED IN HEAVEN FOR YOU:---NO. 2

James Pilgrim

Peter, moved by the Holy Spirit (1 Peter 1:1; 2 Peter 1:20, 21), wrote about “an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you, who are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.” (1 Peter 1:4, 5). Jesus calls upon all who labor and are heavy laden to come unto Him to find rest for their souls, stating that His yoke is easy, and his burden is light. (Matthew 11:28-30). Those who come to Jesus and remain faithful (Mark 13:13; 1 Corinthians 15:58) will receive and enjoy this reserved inheritance, described by Jesus as a great reward. (Matthew 5:10-12).

Who will receive this incorruptible, undefiled, non-fading, reserved inheritance in heaven? First, who will not receive it? Jesus said, “Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven;....” (Matthew 7:21a). Jesus then described some of those who will not enjoy what was reserved in heaven, describing them as having “prophesied,” “cast out devils,” and “done many wonderful works” in my name. (Verse 22). Jesus then said, “I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.” (Verse 23).

“To the saints and faithful brethren in Christ, which are at Colosse” (Colossians 1:2), Paul (Verse 1), as he was “moved by the Holy Ghost” (2 Peter 1:20, 21), wrote, “For the hope which is laid up for you in heaven, whereof ye heard before in the word of truth of the gospel.” The beloved “apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God,” (Colossians 1:1) then wrote of their faithfulness, informed them that he was praying for them, and desired that they “might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding.” (Colossians 1:6ff). He pled with them to continue their faithfulness in Christ (Verses 10ff), reminding them that they had been (past tense) “translated into the kingdom his dear Son: In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins.” (Colossians 1:13, 14).

By the way, read the entire book of Colossians, circling the words “in,” “by,” “through,” and “with” as they relate to Jesus, and color the inside of the circled words with red. You need to do the same with the letter to the Ephesians. In heaven, Christians will enjoy “a better and an enduring substance.” (Hebrews 10:34). All who live godly will be faithfully preserved unto God’s heavenly kingdom. (2 Timothy 4:18, 6-8). Who are those who will receive this exceeding great and precious promise? First, Jesus said, “Not every one that saith unto me Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven” on earth or in heaven. Who then will enjoy this promise?

The saved will have been saved by grace. (Ephesians 2:8-10). However, one is not saved by grace only, “but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of generation, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; Which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour; That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.” (Titus 3:5-7).

One is also “Justified by faith” (Romans 5:1), but “not by faith only.” (James 2:24-26; Mark 16:16). Faith is preceded hearing the word of God. (Romans 10:17; Mark 12:29).

John the Baptist preached “the baptism of repentance for the remission of sins.” (Luke 3:3). Jesus the Savior preached, “except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish.” (Luke 13:3, 5).

Jesus required one to confess Him before men (Matthew 10:32, 33), which Paul also taught (Romans 10:9, 10), and which Philip said must be with all one’s heart. (Acts 8:37).

Jesus sent His apostles and others forth to baptize believers in His name for the remission of sins. (Matthew 28:18-20; Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38; 1 Peter 3:20, 21).
