A NEW NAME

“The vision of Isaiah the son of Amoz, which he saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem” (Isaiah 1:1), the southern kingdom, was a message by the Holy Ghost (Acts 28:25), from “the word of the Lord.” (Isaiah 1:10). It told them how they had “rebelled against” the Lord, how sin-sick they were (Isaiah 1:2ff), and how God had rendered judgment against them, among other things, in forsaking them, making their land desolate, allowing it to be in wasted. (Isaiah 62:4).

They were a shame in the eyes of the Gentile people. However, God promised to deliver them from the Babylonian captivity, giving them “a new name, which the mouth of the Lord shall name.” (Isaiah 62:2). That name would be “Hephzibah, and thy land Beulah: for the Lord delighteth in thee, and thy land shall be married.” (Isaiah 62:4). A number of prophecies have two meanings; this is one. Much of the book of Isaiah contains prophecies of the coming Christ and His body, Church, Kingdom, House. (Isaiah 2:1-4; 53:1-12). God did deliver His people from Babylonian captivity, and set them up again in their land. (Ezra 1, especially verse 11).

A secondary application to Isaiah 62:2, “and thou shalt be called by a new name, which the mouth of the Lord shall name”, is to be found in Acts 11:26. Luke writes, “And it came to pass, that a whole year they assembled themselves with the church, and taught much people. And the disciples were called Christians first in Antioch.” The Lord, not enemies in derision, named them that. (Isaiah 62:2). This newly established church (Acts 2), which Jesus built as He had promised (Matthew 16:13-19), was called a “flock” (Acts 20:28, 29), and had “sheep.” (Hebrews 13:20; 1 Peter 2:25). They were also called “saints” (Acts 9:13, 32, 41), Greek, HAGIOS, meaning, sacred, pure, blameless, consecrated. (Strong’s Exhaustive Concordance of the Bible, Page 869). “Brother/Brethren” (2 Peter 3:15; Acts 20:32) was another name given by the Lord, the idea being a brotherhood. We are also called “servants” of Jesus (Philippians 1:1) and one another. (Galatians 5:13).

All who have believed and been baptized have put on Christ and are the “children of God ” (Galatians 3:26, 27; Mark 16:15, 16), or as John puts it, “sons of God.” (1 John 3:1, 2). Think of being in the family, as a son or daughter of the Creator of heaven and earth. Is it any wonder that the late and beloved J. A. Thornton answered the question, “How are you?”, as he did, with a BIG smile, saying, “I am fine. My Father owns the world.” If you are a Christian, wear these names proudly, but in a humble way. (1 Peter 5:5, 6).
